## **NASSC'S 2010 GUEST CELEBRITY**

**The North American Sand Soccer Championships** are honored to present U.S. National Beach Soccer Team Coach Eddie Soto as a 2010 Guest Celebrity. Eddie was an All-American at Cal State Fullerton as a forward in 1992 and 1993 and is the No. 2 scorer in Titan history. He still holds the single season for goals in a season with 18 and his team advanced to the NCAA quarter and semifinals.

Eddie completed an outstanding high school and club campaign and was selected twice as a Parade All American and was a leader in the NHB futbol club which won the 1991 National Championship. He was also selected as a member of the U.S. U-18 and U-20 National Teams.

Upon graduating from Cal State Fullerton in 1995 with a Bachelor's Degree in Kinesiology, Eddie was selected in the initial MLS draft by the NY/NJ MetroStars and later by the San Jose Clash. He also played in the A-League with the Orange County Zodiacs and USISL Los Angeles Cobras. He ended his



playing days with the USA Pro Beach Soccer Team.

Eddie is presently Assistant Coach at UCLA, guiding the Bruins to the NCAA College Cup finals in his second season. He has 13 years of coaching experience at the club level. He resides in Long Beach, CA with wife Stephanie and children Fabrizio, Wyatt and Isabella.

Eddie was selected by CONCACAF as USA Beach Soccer Head Coach in 2009 and will be scouting the NASSC "U.S. OPEN" for potential national players.
